An informal caregiver is an unpaid individual, usually a spouse/partner, family member, friend or neighbor, who assists an individual in need of help with ADL's or other living and medical needs. Care is usually given in a home setting and typically includes instrumental activities of daily living (iADL's).

#### **Activities of Daily Living:**

Bathing | Dressing | Eating | Transferring | Toileting | Continence

#### Instrumental Activities of Daily Living:

Household Chores | Meal Preparation | Managing Money & Paying Bills | Shopping

## \$241.7 Billion

- 40% of sole caregivers predecease the patient they are caring for.<sup>7</sup>
